

User Manual for Children's Walkie-Talkie with Rechargeable Battery



Specifications

- Number of main channels: 22
- Number of sub-channels: 99
- Range: up to 5km
- Material: Eco ABS

Basic operations

1. Press the Power button for 3-4s to turn on the walkie-talkie
2. Press the Menu button once to enter the channel settings, and the channel display pattern will start flickering. Use the arrow buttons to select the channel and press the Push-to-Talk button (PTT) to confirm and exit.
3. Press the Menu button twice to select the group code. If you just close it means no code is selected, 01-38 means CTCSS code, 39-99 means DCS code.
4. Press the Menu button 3 times to enter the VOX (Voice-activated transmission) function. You can choose the sensitivity between OF, 1, 2, and 3, and the default "OF" is off.
5. Press the Menu button 4 times to enter the calling tone selection. There are 10 sound choices.
6. Press the Menu button 5 times to enter the button tone selection. You can choose whether you want to hear the tone or you won't.
7. Press the Menu button 6 times to enter the PTT button tone selection. You can choose whether you want to hear the tone when you press the button or you won't.
8. Press the Menu button 7 times to return to the main page or press the PTT button to confirm and return to the main page.
9. To adjust the volume, press the up or down buttons. Up to increase the volume, down to decrease. The volume level is displayed on the screen with 1-8 levels.
10. To avoid additional change to your walkie-talkie, press the lock button for 3 seconds and after the beep, it will lock all buttons except the lock button and PTT button. To unlock, hold the lock button until you hear a beep sound.

Scan the active channels

You can use the walkie-talkie to scan the active channels. When a signal is detected, the radio will stay on that channel for 5 seconds and then will continue to scan.

To turn on channel scanning press the Lamp button for 3-4 seconds. To turn it off, press the PTT/Menu/Mon button. During the scanning process, press any of the arrow buttons to change the scanning direction.
